Essential Duties

- Responsible for revenue management for properties that are on LRO within the White Oak portfolio, working with multiple management companies
- Analyze data from several sources to identify trends and opportunities to improve operating performance
- Conduct weekly pricing calls with 3rd party managers to monitor the relationship between pricing practices, and market performance
- Collaborate and promote the appropriate strategy for optimizing rent revenue for each community
- Effectively respond to pricing concerns and requests
- Prepare weekly, monthly, and quarterly property management reports
- Follow revenue management best practices for new lease and renewal pricing as established by Manager
- Execute pricing plans based on sound, data-driven lease pricing strategy.
- Evaluate and review performance on monthly basis. Work with Manager to implement new strategies when needed
- Provide assistance for forecasts and re-forecasts as requested.
- Perform market research and collaborate with regional leaders to determine position of properties relative to competitors
